Mentoring and Discipleship

There are numerous statements in the Gospel accounts that Jesus makes that I take quite seriously. Some of Jesus statements we may spend hours debating about what "He really meant", i.e. if your hand causes you to sin cut it off, or we must leave everyone to follow Him, or let the dead bury the dead. But some of Jesus statements are quite clear; below you will find a few of His statements that I take to heart.

1. **John 3:3** In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no-one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again. (*Meaning we have to come into a spiritual rebirth in our hearts to spend eternity with God*).
2. **John 14:6** "I am the way and the truth and the life. No-one comes to the Father except through me". (*Meaning relationship through Jesus Christ is the way to salvation and eternal truth and brings us into relationship with God the Father*).
3. **Luke 10:25-37 The Story of the Good Samaritan.** *We are called to love the lost and hurting, Jesus is counter culture to the religious views of many people. Jesus calls us to reach out to those who are not like us.*
4. **John 17:20** – "My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. (*Here Jesus prays for unity in the church, that is something that we need to keep in mind in our various relationships*).
5. **Matthew 28:19-20** "go and make disciples of all nations." *Obedience to this command is what I think is the most difficult.*

At Jesus In The City we have a mentoring program that we are hoping to deepen. Our ministry to men can be hard and taxing. Yet this is the area that we feel bears the most fruit. It takes approximately 5 years from the day a man commits his heart to Jesus to becoming a productive member of society and Gods kingdom. Due to the complicated emotional and spiritual issues that a man goes through, perhaps as a child or in his teen years, there are many snares that come up in this process of mentoring.

Mike Lillie is the Assoc Mentoring Pastor at JICF, and he is working on a new program to bring more help in the area of counseling.

We are hoping and praying to develop a counseling program at JICF to further facilitate the healing and restoration that needs to take place in the men and in their family's lives. Most of the men have children, some of the men are married, and some are not. But the common thread is a deep severing of relationships that needs to be restored.
